

#### Collections

- Albert Brown Collection. Four volumes of Brown's research notes and letters to & from genealogists with family roots in Rothwell.
- <u>E.R. Manley Collection</u>. Photographs now digitized at <u>www.leodis.net</u>. Manley also wrote books, including *Meet the Miner: A Study of the Yorkshire Miner* (1947) and *A Short History of Rothwell* (1980 1989).
- Newscutting Collection. Eight volumes mainly articles from the 1970s-80s, with an alphabetical index.
- W.H. Banks Collection. Several volumes of material on Rothwell's past, mainly 20<sup>th</sup>-century and including Banks' own memories. Also available are Banks' articles on the Jaw Bones, the history of sport in Rothwell and a history of the Haigh Road School. Some of the material is at the Central Library and some at Rothwell Library ask for more details.
