

General material

Newspapers – Among the newspapers in our collection are the Yorkshire Post and Yorkshire Evening Post; a list of our holdings is available on request.

The remainder of our collection is catalogued in our card catalogue, which can accessed in the Local & Family History Library reading room. Although we don't have a complete index to our newspapers, we do have a partial index which staff can search.

Photographs – Our collection of Leeds photographs can be view online: www.leodis.net. We also have a collection of prints and photographs which can be accessed in the Local and Family History Library, which includes images of bomb damage and rescue works, victory celebrations and various 'weeks'. Search under 'World War Two' in the card catalogue.

Yorkshire and Leeds periodicals – We have a large collection of Leeds and Yorkshire periodicals covering a wide variety of topics.

School magazines – Including during the war, e.g. Leeds Grammar School

General ephemera relating to local cultural, social and political events.

Local government material – Including Annual Reports of the different council committees and the Reports of the Leeds Medical Office of Health.

Trade directories – Lists of individuals, businesses, industries, municipal offices, places of worship, educational establishments, local societies etc.

Lists of names on local war memorials – We have a small collection of lists for a number of war memorials in Leeds, Morley and Pudsey.

Ancestry.com military databases - Free access in all Leeds libraries to Ancestry.com. Databases include <u>UK Prisoners of War 1939-45</u> and <u>GB Royal AeroClub Aviators Certificates 1910-1950</u>.

Maps – we have a large collection of Leeds and Yorkshire OS maps dating back to 1850s. We also have a selection of German war maps of Leeds (1940) with various targets marked.

Published histories – Local histories covering different areas of Leeds plus histories of local institutions, organisations, industries, transport, entertainment, etc. Additionally we hold personal histories – reminiscences and stories of WWII experiences.

Annual reports – Annual reports belonging to local charitable organisations and institutions in Leeds.
